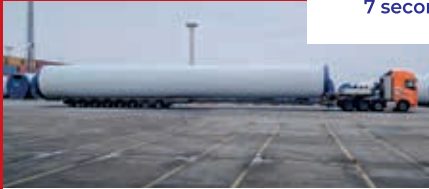


STOP 230m WIND TURBINES RUINING WALES

Fact Sheet

Each turbine weighs approx. 1,000 tonnes:

- That's 400 Range Rovers or 9,000 rugby players.
- They are all imported.
- 230m is more than 2 Meridian Towers (107m), it would take over 7 seconds to fall 230m.



The tower itself weighs 700 tonnes:

- Approx. 10 truck loads at 70 tonnes each, 20m long are needed to move it. (A standard lorry load is 28 tonnes and 14m long).

The nacelle weighs 200 tonnes:

- It is the part the blades are connected to and is full of lubricating oil.
- Two specialised vehicles are needed.
- Full police escort needed.
- Limited road speed.
- Very heavy-duty roads and bridges are required to move it.



Each blade weighs 40 tonnes:

- Three blades per turbine.
- Each one is almost as long as a rugby pitch.
- Specialist trailers and a full police escort needed to transport them.
- Blade lifetime is only 20 years.
- None are recyclable; they are all buried in landfill.
- Shed micro-plastics from leading edge.
- Blade tips move at over 500 mph; they kill numerous birds.



In addition, 3,000 tonnes of steel reinforced concrete foundation are needed for each turbine!

- How much work is that?
- How many trucks, diggers, pumps, workers?



Then there are the cranes:

- 1,000 tonne cranes needed for construction.
- 100 tonne base unit with support trucks to carry extra boom sections and counter weights.
- Can be up to 40 trucks involved.
